For reference:

The purpose of the Institution is to increase the effectiveness of state policy in the sphere of road management by ensuring the functioning of information and analytical system of road management, aimed to support the road safety.

The institution is a state budget non-profit organization, which is based on the state property and fully supported by the state budget and one of its funding sources are grants, international technical assistance, gratuitous and charitable contributions received in the manner, prescribed by law.

As far as we know, the project on creation of the National Access Point (NAP) to the information about the state of traffic is one of the projects implemented under the National Traffic Management System (KSZR) program and is jointly prepared by the

General Directorate of National Roads and Motorways and Ministry of Infrastructure and Construction Republic of Poland.

The aim of the project is to provide travellers with reliable information about obstacles on all roads in Poland, as well as in selected countries of the European Union (EU) through international data exchange between national access points.

Currently, the European Commission has decided to change and include four Ukrainian roads in the TEN-T network.

After Ukraine has been granted the EU candidate status, the goal of our Institution is to find experienced partners, which undoubtedly are Polish state institutions, and to establish international cooperation with similar institutions of countries that are already members of the EU.
